Cookie Policy

1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how **ClicknScript** uses cookies, local storage and similar technologies when users visit or use **clicknscript.com**.

These technologies may be used to:

- operate essential website functions;
- maintain secure user sessions;
- remember language and consent preferences;
- process payments;
- measure website usage;
- measure advertising performance.

Some technologies are strictly necessary for ClicknScript to function and may be used without prior consent where permitted by law.

Analytics and marketing technologies are activated only after the user has given the required consent.

This Cookie Policy should be read together with the **Privacy Policy**.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on a user's device when visiting a website.

They can help websites:

- recognize a browser or session;
- maintain authentication;
- remember preferences;
- measure website traffic;
- understand how users interact with pages;
- support advertising measurement.

ClicknScript may also use technologies such as **local storage** that perform similar functions without necessarily creating a traditional browser cookie.

For simplicity, this Policy may refer collectively to these technologies as “cookies and similar technologies”.

3. Categories Used by ClicknScript

ClicknScript currently separates cookies and similar technologies into the following categories.

Necessary

These technologies are required for the website to function correctly.

They may be used for:

- account authentication;
- session security;
- fraud prevention;
- essential website functionality;
- language preferences;
- consent management;
- payment processing.

Necessary technologies cannot be disabled through the ClicknScript consent manager where they are required to provide the Service.

Analytics

Analytics technologies help ClicknScript understand how visitors use the website.

They may collect information such as:

- pages visited;
- session duration;
- browser or device information;
- general interactions with the website;
- approximate geographic information;
- pseudonymous analytics identifiers.

Analytics technologies are activated only after the user consents to the **Analytics** category.

Marketing

Marketing technologies may be used to measure advertising performance and understand whether advertising campaigns result in visits or other relevant actions.

Marketing technologies are activated only after the user consents to the **Marketing** category.

4. Technologies Currently Used

4.1 ClicknScript Consent Preferences

Technology: `clicknscript-consent`

Provider: ClicknScript

Category: Necessary

Purpose: Stores the user's cookie and consent choices.

Storage: Browser local storage or equivalent storage mechanism.

Duration: Until the user withdraws or changes consent, clears browser storage, or ClicknScript changes the applicable consent-policy version.

Consent required: No.

This technology allows ClicknScript to remember whether the user has accepted, rejected or customized optional cookie categories.

4.2 Language Preference

Technology: `clicknscript-locale`

Provider: ClicknScript

Category: Necessary / Preference

Purpose: Remembers whether the user prefers the French or English version of ClicknScript.

Storage: Browser local storage or equivalent storage mechanism.

Duration: Until deleted or replaced by the user or browser.

Consent required: No.

4.3 Authentication and Session Technologies

Provider: ClicknScript / Supabase

Category: Necessary

Purpose: Authentication, account access and session security.

When users sign in, ClicknScript uses Supabase authentication infrastructure to maintain the authenticated session.

Depending on the technical configuration of the Service, session information may be stored through secure cookies, browser storage or related authentication mechanisms.

These technologies may contain:

- session identifiers;
- authentication tokens;
- token-expiration information;
- technical information required to maintain secure access to an account.

They do not contain the user's password in readable form.

Duration: Session duration or the authentication duration configured by ClicknScript and Supabase.

Consent required: No, where required to provide authentication requested by the user.

The exact technical cookie names may vary according to the Supabase configuration used by ClicknScript.

5. Google Analytics 4

ClicknScript may use **Google Analytics 4 (“GA4”)** to understand general website usage.

Google Analytics is classified as **Analytics** and remains disabled until the user gives Analytics consent.

Common GA4 technologies may include:

_ga

Provider: Google

Category: Analytics

Purpose: Helps distinguish pseudonymous visitors and measure website usage.

Typical maximum duration: Up to approximately 2 years, depending on the configuration and browser restrictions.

Activated: Only after Analytics consent.

ga<identifier>

Provider: Google

Category: Analytics

Purpose: Used to maintain and measure session-related information for a specific Google

Analytics property.

Typical maximum duration: Up to approximately 2 years, depending on configuration and browser restrictions.

Activated: Only after Analytics consent.

The exact identifiers attached to GA cookies depend on ClicknScript's Google Analytics configuration.

6. Information Sent to Google Analytics

Where Analytics consent has been granted, ClicknScript may use GA4 to measure standard website interactions.

ClicknScript does not intentionally send Google Analytics:

- passwords;
- payment-card information;
- API keys;
- full generated scripts;
- complete video transcripts;
- complete user prompts;
- authentication credentials;
- plain-text email addresses.

Analytics data is used to understand website usage and improve ClicknScript.

7. TikTok Pixel

ClicknScript may use **TikTok Pixel** for advertising measurement.

TikTok Pixel is classified as **Marketing** and remains disabled until the user gives Marketing consent.

Depending on TikTok's configuration, technologies may include identifiers such as:

- `_ttp;`
- `ttcsid;`
- `ttcsid_<pixel identifier>;`
- `_tt_enable_cookie;`
- `ttclid` or related advertising identifiers.

These names and technologies may change according to TikTok's technical configuration.

Purpose

TikTok Pixel may be used to:

- measure website visits resulting from advertising;
- evaluate campaign performance;
- attribute advertising interactions;
- understand general conversion events.

Duration

Certain TikTok advertising cookies or identifiers may remain for up to approximately **13 months**, depending on the specific technology and TikTok's configuration.

Activation

TikTok Pixel must remain blocked before the user grants **Marketing** consent.

8. TikTok Advanced Matching

ClicknScript does **not currently intend to use TikTok Advanced Matching**.

ClicknScript therefore does not intentionally send information such as a user's plain-text email address or name to TikTok for Advanced Matching purposes.

If this practice changes in the future, this Cookie Policy and the relevant consent information will be updated where required.

9. Meta Pixel

Meta Pixel is not currently used by ClicknScript.

ClicknScript does not currently activate Meta/Facebook advertising tracking through its cookie consent system.

If Meta Pixel is introduced in the future, the Cookie Policy and consent interface will be updated before or when required by applicable law.

10. Stripe and Payment Technologies

Payments for ClicknScript subscriptions and Credit packs are processed through **Stripe**.

Stripe may use cookies or similar technologies on its own payment pages and services for purposes including:

- payment execution;
- fraud prevention;
- authentication;
- security;
- regulatory compliance.

These technologies are considered necessary for completing a payment requested by the user.

Their names and retention periods are determined by Stripe and may vary according to the payment method, browser and Stripe configuration.

ClicknScript does not use Stripe payment cookies for advertising purposes.

ClicknScript does not store full payment-card numbers or card security codes on its own servers.

11. Google OAuth

Users may choose to sign into ClicknScript using **Google OAuth**.

Google may use its own necessary authentication technologies during the Google sign-in process.

These technologies are controlled by Google and may be necessary to:

- authenticate the Google account;
- protect the login process;
- maintain Google security features.

Using Google OAuth does not automatically mean that the user has consented to Google Analytics.

Authentication technologies and Analytics consent are treated separately by ClicknScript.

12. Necessary Cookies Do Not Require Optional Consent

Technologies strictly necessary to:

- keep the website secure;
- authenticate users;
- maintain sessions;
- remember cookie choices;
- provide essential preferences;
- complete payments requested by the user;

may operate before the user accepts Analytics or Marketing cookies.

Rejecting optional cookies should not prevent the user from accessing the core functionality of ClicknScript where those optional technologies are not necessary for the requested service.

13. Consent Choices

When required, ClicknScript provides users with choices allowing them to:

- **Accept all** optional cookies;
- **Reject all** optional cookies;
- select individual categories.

Analytics and Marketing technologies remain disabled unless the user has granted the relevant consent.

Refusing optional cookies does not create a paid disadvantage or prevent access to essential website functionality.

14. Manage or Withdraw Consent

Users can change their cookie choices at any time through the:

Manage cookies

link available in the ClicknScript footer or consent interface.

Withdrawing consent prevents future activation of the relevant optional technologies.

Withdrawal does not affect processing that lawfully occurred before consent was withdrawn.

Users may also delete existing cookies through their browser settings.

15. Browser Controls

Most browsers allow users to:

- view cookies;
- delete cookies;
- block specific cookies;
- block all cookies;
- clear local storage;
- automatically remove cookies when the browser closes.

Blocking necessary authentication or session technologies may prevent certain ClicknScript features from working correctly.

16. Cookie Duration

Cookies may be:

Session cookies

Deleted or invalidated when the relevant browser session or authenticated session ends.

Persistent cookies

Stored for a defined period unless the user deletes them earlier.

The effective duration of a cookie may also be shortened by:

- browser privacy protections;
 - operating-system restrictions;
 - provider configuration;
 - user settings.

Some providers used for Analytics, Marketing, authentication or payment processing may process information outside France or the European Economic Area.

Where applicable, such processing is handled subject to the safeguards and transfer mechanisms described in the **ClicknScript Privacy Policy**.

19. Updates to This Cookie Policy

ClicknScript may update this Cookie Policy if:

- new technologies are introduced;
- existing cookies are removed;
- providers change their technical implementation;
- retention periods change;
- consent requirements change;
- legal or regulatory requirements evolve.

The updated version will display a revised **Last updated** date.

Where required, ClicknScript may request renewed consent after a material change.
