

ClicknScript – Corporate Policy

Copyright Policy

Last updated: August 7, 2026

1. Introduction

ClicknScript respects intellectual property rights and expects users of the Service to do the same.

This Copyright Policy explains how copyright holders or their authorized representatives may report content or use of content that they believe infringes their rights through **clicknscript.com**.

ClicknScript may review valid copyright complaints and take appropriate action where required by applicable law.

2. User Responsibility

Users are responsible for ensuring that they have the necessary rights, licenses, permissions or other lawful basis to submit, process or reuse content through ClicknScript.

This applies in particular to:

- YouTube videos;
- transcripts;
- text;
- prompts;
- images;
- audio;
- scripts;
- trademarks;
- copyrighted works;
- and other third-party materials.

The technical ability to submit a URL or process content through ClicknScript does not mean that ClicknScript grants the user permission to use that content.

3. Third-Party Content

ClicknScript may allow users to process content originating from third-party platforms, including YouTube or other online services.

All intellectual property rights in third-party content remain with their respective rights holders.

ClicknScript does not claim ownership of third-party videos, music, images, trademarks or other protected materials simply because they are accessible or processed through the Service.

Users remain responsible for determining whether their use of such content is lawful.

4. AI-Generated Content

As between ClicknScript and the user, and to the extent permitted by applicable law, ClicknScript does not claim ownership of scripts generated for the user through the Service.

However, AI-generated content may not always qualify for copyright protection in every jurisdiction.

Generated outputs may also not be unique. Similar or identical ideas, structures, phrases or outputs may be generated for different users.

ClicknScript therefore does not guarantee that any generated output is:

- unique;
- copyrightable;
- free from all third-party rights;
- or suitable for registration as intellectual property.

Users should review and adapt generated content before publication or commercial exploitation.

5. Reporting Copyright Infringement

A copyright holder, or an authorized representative acting on their behalf, may report suspected infringement involving ClicknScript.

Reports should contain enough information to allow ClicknScript to identify:

- the person making the complaint;
- the protected work concerned;

- the allegedly infringing material;
- the location of the material;
- and the basis of the complaint.

Incomplete reports may require additional information before they can be reviewed.

6. Information Required in a Copyright Report

A copyright complaint should include:

Identity of the rights holder

Provide:

- full name or legal entity name;
- email address;
- country;
- and, where relevant, professional contact details.

If the report is submitted by a representative, the representative should identify the rights holder they represent.

Identification of the protected work

Describe the copyrighted work sufficiently to allow ClicknScript to understand what is protected.

Where possible, provide:

- title;
- author or creator;
- original publication URL;
- registration reference, if applicable;
- or another reliable means of identifying the work.

Identification of the material concerned

Provide the exact URL, account, script, project or other location associated with the alleged infringement.

General statements such as “someone copied my content” may not be sufficient to investigate a complaint.

Explanation of the infringement

Explain why the material is believed to infringe the protected work.

Evidence or authority

Where reasonably available, provide evidence supporting ownership of the rights or authorization to act on behalf of the rights holder.

Good-faith declaration

The complainant should confirm that they have a good-faith belief that the disputed use is not authorized by:

- the copyright owner;
- their representative;
- or applicable law.

Accuracy declaration

The complainant should confirm that the information provided is accurate to the best of their knowledge.

Signature

The report should include the complainant's electronic or physical signature, or another clear indication that the report is being formally submitted by the identified person.

7. Where to Submit a Copyright Report

Copyright reports may be submitted through the ClicknScript contact form or by email to:

clicknscript@gmail.com

The subject line should preferably include:

Copyright Report

to facilitate processing.

8. Review Procedure

After receiving a sufficiently detailed report, ClicknScript may:

1. acknowledge receipt of the complaint;
2. review the information provided;
3. examine the relevant material or account;
4. request additional evidence or clarification;

5. contact the affected user where appropriate;
6. determine whether technical or account action is justified.

The existence of a complaint does not automatically prove infringement.

ClicknScript may consider the available evidence and applicable law before taking action.

9. Possible Actions

Where appropriate, ClicknScript may take measures including:

- restricting access to disputed material;
- removing stored content;
- disabling access to a specific feature or result;
- warning the relevant user;
- suspending an account in serious or repeated cases;
- preserving relevant records where required for legal purposes.

The action taken will depend on the nature and seriousness of the report.

10. Requests for Additional Information

ClicknScript may ask the complainant to provide additional information where a report is:

- incomplete;
- unclear;
- unsupported;
- internally inconsistent;
- or insufficient to identify the alleged infringement.

A report may remain unresolved until sufficient information is provided.

11. Notice to the User Concerned

Where appropriate and legally permitted, ClicknScript may inform the affected user that a copyright complaint has been received.

This notification may include sufficient information to allow the user to understand and respond to the complaint.

ClicknScript may withhold information where disclosure would be inappropriate for legal, privacy, security or fraud-prevention reasons.

12. Disputing a Copyright Report

A user who believes that material was incorrectly identified or restricted may contact ClicknScript and explain why they believe:

- they own the relevant rights;
- they obtained permission;
- the use is lawful;
- the content was misidentified;
- or the complaint is otherwise incorrect.

The user should provide supporting information where available.

ClicknScript may review the matter again before deciding whether to maintain, modify or reverse an action.

13. False or Abusive Reports

Copyright reporting procedures must not be used to:

- harass users;
- suppress lawful criticism;
- make knowingly false allegations;
- impersonate a rights holder;
- interfere with competitors;
- or abuse the reporting process.

ClicknScript may reject reports that appear manifestly fraudulent, abusive or submitted in bad faith.

Where appropriate, repeated abuse of the reporting system may result in restrictions on further submissions.

Nothing in this section prevents ClicknScript from complying with valid legal obligations or court orders.

14. Repeat Infringement

Users who repeatedly or seriously infringe third-party intellectual property rights may have their access to ClicknScript restricted or terminated.

ClicknScript may consider:

- the number of valid complaints;
 - the seriousness of the conduct;
 - whether the user acted knowingly;
 - previous warnings;
 - and other relevant circumstances.
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15. ClicknScript Intellectual Property

The ClicknScript platform itself may contain protected intellectual property, including:

- the ClicknScript name;
- logo;
- branding;
- website interface;
- original graphics;
- design elements;
- proprietary texts;
- source code;
- software;
- databases;
- workflows;
- and other original materials.

Unless otherwise stated, these elements may not be copied, reproduced, distributed, modified or commercially exploited without authorization, except where permitted by applicable law.

16. Trademarks

Third-party trademarks, logos, platform names and brand identifiers displayed or referenced through ClicknScript remain the property of their respective owners.

ClicknScript is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by or affiliated with **YouTube, Google, TikTok, ByteDance, Meta, Facebook, Instagram**, or other third-party platforms merely because those services are referenced or supported.

17. No Legal Determination by ClicknScript

ClicknScript is not a court and does not make final legal determinations regarding ownership of intellectual property.

When disputes involve complex questions of ownership, licensing, fair use, exceptions to copyright or other legal issues, the parties may need to seek independent legal advice or pursue the remedies available under applicable law.

ClicknScript may nevertheless take reasonable interim measures to protect users, rights holders and the Service.

18. Cooperation With Legal Authorities

Where required by applicable law, valid court order or another legally binding request, ClicknScript may preserve or disclose information relating to an alleged infringement.

Any such processing of personal data will be handled in accordance with the ClicknScript Privacy Policy and applicable law.

19. Changes to This Policy

- new reporting procedures;
- operational or security requirements.
